This trip will have a heavy focus on chairlift-accessed ski-touring with the majority of the time spent descending steeps powder runs and exploring all that Hakuba and the surrounding mountains has to offer. Let our ACMG and CSIA certified guides show you the best of both worlds--you will push into the alpine when the weather permits, and stay low and enjoy the untracked, unmatched tree skiing of Hakuba during the storms—and even check out some runs that lead right to the Izakaya at the end of the day (also known as Après'). There are as many as 12 uncommonly skied ridgelines to choose from just outside the resort boundaries, allowing us to pick and choose the terrain and lines we ski. The area boasts the largest peaks in Japan, offering the opportunity to get into the beautiful Hakuba alpine.

Apres' activities include a soak in the onsen (hot springs), experiencing the historical architecture and culture of the town, and re-fueling with traditional Japanese cuisine for the next big day of powder skiing. Hakuba packs a punch as a town with it's unique architecture, traditional food, and most importantly—world class skiing. If you are looking for a markedly different world of exploring, skiing, and dining—you have come to the right place.

A \$1000 deposit is due upon booking. Final payment is due 60 days prior to departure. The credit card on file will be automatically charged for the balance 60 days prior to departure. If paying by cheque, a post-dated cheque for the final payment is required upon booking. For bookings made within 60 days of departure, full payment is due upon booking. You will be sent a written confirmation of your booking by email, mail or fax. Payments can be made by cash, cheque, money order, bank transfer, Visa, Diners, Mastercard or American Express.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be made in writing to Extremely Canadian by mail, email or fax and are not considered canceled until acknowledged by return mail, email or fax by Extremely Canadian. Cancellations made outside of 60 days to departure will forfeit the deposit. Cancellations made 60 days or less to departure will result in forfeiture of the full amount.
